

HOLIDAY NAPKIN RINGS

Materials:

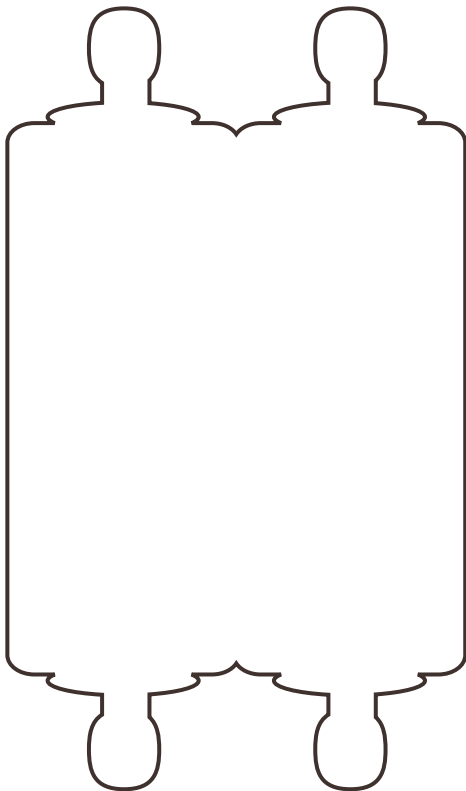
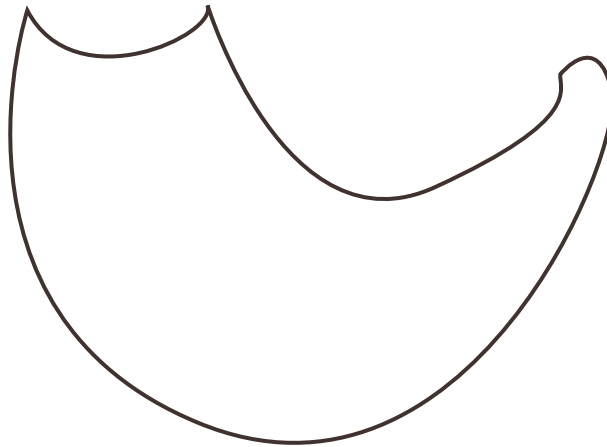
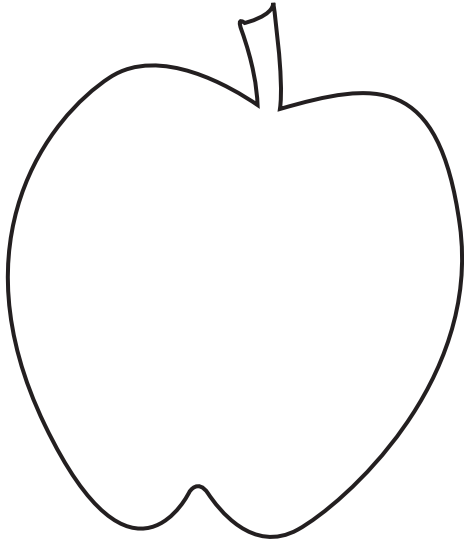
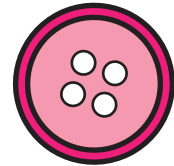
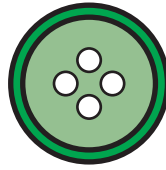
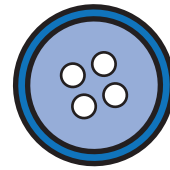
Felt sheets - red, tan, blue or any colors you like!

Pipe cleaners - silver or gold, or any colors you like!

Buttons with 2 or 4 holes - metal or plastic in any colors you like!

Sharp Scissors

Thick safety pin or needle



Use the apple, shofar and Torah templates, enlarge if necessary or desired. Glue to thin cardboard, like an empty cereal box and cut out for tracing. Trace the number of desired napkin rings using one, or all of the templates onto felt and then cut out with sharp scissors.

Position a button in the center of the felt shape and use the safety pin or needle to poke two holes. Bend pipe cleaner into a "U" shape and push each end through the button and the holes. Twist once or twice behind the button, then shape the pipe cleaner ends into a circle. Wrap the ends around to create a loop.
