

Paper Hamentaschen

Use as place cards or decorations!

You will need:

Light brown construction paper, Scissors, Glue, Tissue or crepe paper in orange, brown, red, Paper Clips

Optional: String, Hole Punch, Markers

1. Cut out circles from light brown construction paper. 5" or 6" in diameter is a good place to start.
2. Fold in edges of the circle 3 times to form a Hamentashen shape, and unfold loosely.
3. Tear tissue paper or crepe paper into little tufts, smear glue into center of the circle and glue on tufts in different colors for different fillings. Use orange for apricot, red for raspberry and purple or dark brown for poppy!
4. Place a glue line along the edge of the folds and pinch them together, secure with small paper clips until dry and then carefully remove paper clips.

Try using larger or smaller circles to make different sizes.

Write guests' names on one edge to use for place cards.

Punch a hole along one side, tie and string for a mobile or garland.
